Earlier this year, Barbara Bean and Midge Renton

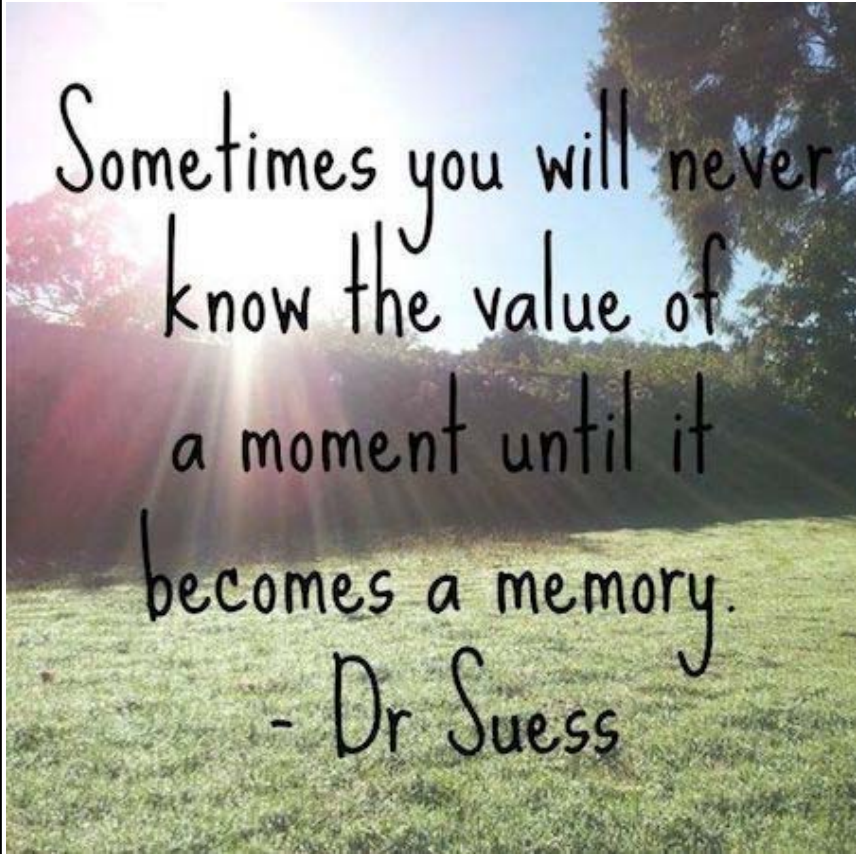
traveled to New Mexico on a Rotary Friendship Exchange.
