**\*\*NOTE:** Generally, funds are awarded only for capital projects with a priority of benefitting children and to be completed within one year of the award. Maximum award is \$1,500.00. Capital projects may include items such as program supplies (instruments, books, videos, etc.) but not ongoing operating expenses including salaries, rents, mortgages or debt retirements. Matching funds (cash and inkind) are considered in making the awards.

**\*\*\*NOTE:** Organizations that have received three consecutive grant awards from the club are asked to sit-out one application cycle before a new submission is made.
